## Remarks at a State Dinner for President Luiz Inacio Lula da Silva of the Federal Republic of Brazil

a new leap forward in substantive cooperation. In particular, your visit this time at the head of a large economic mission of as many as 180 persons will expedite such collaboration. Korea hopes that cooperation with Brazil, which is now leaping to the center of the world beyond South America, will be further expanded.
