It is my great pleasure to sign today, on behalf of the Government of the Republic of Korea, the Korea-Singapore Free Trade Agreement, which represents the successful culmination of so much hard work by both sides. I wish to express my utmost gratitude to you, Minister Lim, for visiting Korea to sign this Agreement in person.

Five rounds of formal negotiations, numerous meetings and discussions over the past year and a half since their launch in January 2004 have lead to the conclusion of the Korea-Singapore FTA. Singapore is known as a leading business hub in Southeast Asia, while Korea aims to become a Northeast Asian hub. In this regard, this Agreement will serve as a bridge between Northeast and Southeast Asia. And even more than that, it will prove an important step towards achieving economic integration in East Asia as a whole.

This Agreement is a natural extension of the existing close relations between the two countries.

I am confident that it will serve as a stepping stone to take the bilateral relationship to a higher level. We will see that through the Korea-Singapore FTA, we have provided, at the right time, a greater opportunity for peace and prosperity we aspire to.
